English

In English, we will continue to explore writing a range of texts including a setting description, an information text about plants, retell of stories and explanations of our findings in science. We will continue developing our knowledge of spelling rules including homophones and compound words. We will be encouraging accurate use of a variety of conjunctions and punctuation including apostrophes for possession and contraction.

Our texts are:

Non-Fiction about Habitats
How to help a hedgehog and protect a polar bear

Reading at Home

All children are expected to read every day. An adult should record on their child's bookmark that they have read. Children who are on Accelerated Reader should be encouraged to answer simple verbal questions about what they have read to prepare them for their quizzes. We encourage children to access Reading Eggs at home.

Maths

This term in Maths, we will continue to secure our understanding of column addition and subtraction methods. We will focus on ensuring we know our number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 including doubles to help our arithmetic skills. We will focus on multiplication and division methods whilst recalling known times table to answer questions. In Summer 2, we will also investigate measure, length and weight.

Science

As Scientists, this term we will begin by exploring plants, we will look at what plants need to survive and carry out different experiments. We will also have the opportunity to plant different plants to observe over a period of time. We will then learn about humans including how to stay healthy and the importance of a good diet and exercise. Finally we will learn about habitats and their animals.
