English

In English, we will looking at the text Jack and Baked beanstalk to write a recount letter where we will be applying our skills from our place value of punctuation and grammar learning we have been learning this year.

This will be followed by a range of different writing outcomes to allow the children to show they are an expected Year 3 writer as we move towards the end of Summer term.

Key writing skills - using co-ordinating and subordinating conjunction, adverbials of place and time, apostrophes for contraction and singular possession.

Reading at Home

All children are expected to read every day. An adult should record on their child's bookmark that they have read.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be increasing our Maths fluency so that we can add and subtract speedily across a ten. We will continue to develop our times table knowledge. Children need to be able to recall their 3, 4, 8 times tables. We will also be learning to tell the time to the the nearest minute and be exploring am and pm whilst reading the time on a digital clock.

Science

As Scientists this term we will be learning about forces and magnets. We will learn about contact forces and how the forces can make an object start or top moving, change direction, speed or shape. We will be carrying out an investigation to see how far an object can move when pushed and if different materials will make an object travel further or not because of friction.
