English

In English we will be learning to write simple sentences with capital letters and full stops. We will focus on our handwriting and ensuring our letters begin at the correct starting points.

Our texts are:

Reading at Home

All children are expected to read every day. An adult should record on their child's bookmark that they have read. Please also practise red words which will be given with your child's reading folder.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be learning to count accurately and we will be recording using pictures and numerals. We will use addition and subtraction symbols and be introduced to comparing numbers using the greater than and less than symbols. We will order numerals using number lines and extend our knowledge beyond ten.

Geography

As Geographers this term we will be learning about the area where we live. We will begin by mapping our route around school. We will learn to recognise places unique to our city of Coventry and the story of Lady Godiva. We will learn what a human and physical feature is and recognise them in our local area and in our city. We will learn which countries make up the United Kingdom, their capital cities and the foods which traditionally might be found there.
